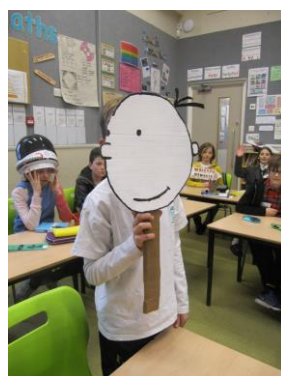

This year we will be participating in Sport Relief activities from Monday 19th to Friday 23rd March.

Sport Relief is all about getting young people active and improving the lives of others in the UK and around the World. In the past you have been extremely generous with your sponsorship and donations and this year we'd like you to do the same again please.

So! What are we doing? Throughout the week: PE pentathlons, running/walking a mile a day, lunchtime tournaments, dancing, counting steps to school, step class and a carousel of different sporting events, assemblies and discussions about the work of Sport/Comic Relief.
