## Re. Final Rehearsal and Performance of the Totally Thames Festival Kids' Choir

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to the new school year, I hope that you all had a fantastic summer!

These are the final details for the Totally Thames Festival Kids' Choir rehearsal and performance, Please let me know ASAP if any of it causes problems! The rehearsal is next **Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> September**, at George the Martyr Church in Borough, and the performance is on **Sunday, 16<sup>th</sup> September** at The Scoop, MORE London.

We will be travelling to the rehearsal by train and tube on **Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup>**, meeting at the Village entrance to Dulwich Hamlet at 8:45am in order to catch the 9:06 train from North Dulwich. **Please provide your child with a packed lunch and a drink** as we will eat at the venue. Some of our time will be spent outside so please make sure they will be warm and/or dry as the weather requires. We will be back at school before the end of the school day.

On **Sunday 16<sup>th</sup>**, I would like to meet the children outside North Dulwich train station at 10:00am, we are going to walk up to Red Post Hill and catch a bus. We need to be at City Hall for registration from 10.30am.

The children will need to be wearing school uniform. Not knowing what the weather is likely to do, please make sure they are wearing sunscreen and have a hat if it is warm, and jumper and coat if it is cold or damp. The children will be outside for most of the day so please check the forecast closer to the time to prepare!

We will have a rehearsal with all of the performers when we arrive, which will be followed by a short break for the children before the main event. **Please provide your child with a drink and a small packed lunch** (there will not be very long to eat so please bear this in mind when packing!).

Once we are at City Hall, Mrs Purcell and myself will be the only adults allowed to enter the space where the children will be, so please ensure that they have everything they need before they leave in the morning. In case of emergency, I will be taking your contact details with me. Please ensure that the office has the most up-to-date information.

The performance starts at 1pm at the Scoop, which is by City Hall on the South Bank: nearest station – London Bridge. It is a free, outside event, open to all, so do come early to get a good view. The performance will finish at about 2pm when the children will be ready to be **collected directly from the venue** (instructions for how to do this safely will be given by Thames Festival staff on the day). If you are not able to be at the performance, please contact me directly regarding making arrangements for collecting your child from the venue as **I will not be returning to Dulwich**.

Please could you return the below permission slip as soon as possible so I know you are aware of all the details mentioned.
