



Dulwich Hamlet Junior School: COVID-19 Key Information for Visitors

All visitors are asked to follow the guidance below:

Do

- ✓ Wear a face mask in the main school office, and if directed to by a member of staff in other areas of the school site
- ✓ Sanitise and/or wash your hands for at least 20 seconds on arrival
- ✓ Wash your hands often for at least 20 seconds, specifically if your visit is for more than one hour
- ✓ Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze
- ✓ Put used tissues straight in the bin and wash your hands afterwards
- ✓ Maintain a safe distance (at least one metre, and ideally two metres) from other people at all times
- ✓ Please refrain from touching surfaces/resources during your visit, unless essential to your visit
- ✓ Scan the NHS track and trace QR code
- ✓ Provide a contact telephone number with the Admin team
- ✓ Ask a member of staff if you wish to use the toilet facilities while on-site, who will direct you where to go

Don't

- X Enter the school if you are feeling unwell or have been in close contact with any person who is displaying COVID-19 symptoms (new continuous cough, high temperature and / or a change to your sense of smell or taste) within the last 14 days
- X Be offended if any of our staff members do not offer a handshake as a greeting
- X Touch your eyes, nose or mouth if your hands are not clean
- X Enter other areas of the school without permission from a staff member
