



Y2 Dulwich Village C of E Infant's School Transition to Dulwich Hamlet Junior School

Every year, a significant proportion of Y2 DVIS children transfer to the neighbouring DHJS. For September 2018, 78% of the DHJS Y3 cohort transferred from DVIS.

Both schools are three form entry, taking 90 pupils into Reception (DVIS) and Year 3 (DHJS) each academic year. It is important to note that there is **no automatic transfer** from the Infants to the Junior School, when children leave DVIS at the end of Year Two. Each school apply their own separate admissions criteria.

However, the schools do work closely together and there is an excellent relationship between both schools. A thorough transition process takes place for the children transferring which has been established over many years.

In 2018, 99% of DVIS children who applied for a place at DHJS were offered a place.

DHJS does not have a catchment area as such; children who live closest to the school on the basis of straight line measurement will be admitted, so the 'catchment' changes every year. Listed below are details of the furthest distances in metres from the past few years.
