At School

Options for Home Learning

This half term we will be studying The Stone Age Boy by Satoshi Kitamura. We will be using this book to learn about writing instructions for our Stone Age Survival Guide. Do you have the skills to survive the Stone Age?

You could:

- Read some Stone Age stories, for example Stig of the Dump by Clive King.
- Create your very own Stone Age language
- Draw and write a postcard from the Stone Age back to the present day. What did you do on your Stone Age holiday?

Science

We will be learning about Rocks in Science this half term. We will use a range of practical activities to find out about the fossilisation process and will be investigating different rock types.

- Investigate the story and work of the inspiring palaeontologist, Mary Anning. Some of her best finds can be seen at the Natural History Museum.
- Go rock hunting -how many different types of rocks did you find?

In History, we will be thinking about • Pre-Roman Britain. The children will develop their understanding of different periods of time from the Palaeolithic to the Neolithic age.

- Check out the Pre-historic collection at the Museum of London.
- Investigate Stonehenge and make your own model. You could use playdough, recycling or even biscuits!

In Art, we will study Bridget Riley's Op Art. In French, we will be learning how to say places in the UK and phrases for basic conversation, and in RE, we will learn about pilgrimage and Christian places of worship.

- Watch an Op Art tutorial online. Have a go at creating your own piece.
- Create a poster on the 12 French sounds we have learnt. Then, use this to teach somebody at home how to pronounce each sound.
