



Dulwich Hamlet Junior School Remote Peripatetic Instrumental Lessons Parental Agreement

January 2021

In signing-up for our remote learning instrumental tuition offer, I am agreeing to:

- Provide a quiet space for the weekly lessons: Lessons should take place in a neutral area, where nothing inappropriate can be seen or heard in the background, ideally not in a bedroom, where the child will not be interrupted
- Ensure resources are available at home for my child to access the lesson, including having a device with a microphone and camera available, as well as a secure internet connection
- Ensure that my child 'enters' the lesson promptly, at the correct time each week, with instrument, music, and green book/pencil to hand
- Ensure my child is wearing suitable clothing for the duration of the 'live' lesson, as should anyone else in the household who may 'appear' on the screen
- Not record or image capture the lesson, or indeed any part of the lesson
- Not share any aspect of the lesson on social media
- I understand that if a DHJS tutor suspects a child is unsupervised at home, or has any other safeguarding concerns, this will be referred immediately to the DHJS Designated Safeguarding Lead for investigation.
