Generally, if a French noun ends in an **e**, it's probably feminine. E.g. une chaussette (a sock), une porte (a door). Of course, there are LOTS of exceptions!

The word **j'ai** means **I have**. The word is actually two words put together: **je** (I) and **ai** (have).
